Writ of Certiorari

The basis of this controversy lies within the plaintiff, Kaden Madson, appealing a discrepancy between official election documents pertaining to prospective candidates for executive office in the ASUU. The defendant in this case is the ASUU Elections Committee, which decided that the plaintiff is ineligible to run for executive office in the coming ASUU election. The aforementioned discrepancy lies between Article IV, Section 1, line 1.2 of the Constitution of the Associated Students of the University of Utah, which states “The President shall have completed forty-five (45) credit hours (or equivalent) prior to the ASUU Elections filing deadline.” However, page six (6) of the Executive 2018-2019 Candidate Packet explicitly states a filing deadline of January 25th, 2019 at 5:00 pm. All Justices: Ariel Flores Mena, Cameron Owen, Chandler Blount, Dillon Clark, Mihali Sergakis, and Tanvi Singh, have voted unanimously to hear this case with authority from Article V, section 1, 3.1.1 of the Constitution of the Associated Students of the University of Utah.
